Eligibility

All delegates must provide documentary evidence showing that they have successfully completed the appropriate Practical Test(s) of Basic Operating Skills, for the machine type used during the course (please note the machine will be a Counterbalance Lift Truck). The operating test must have been successfully taken within the 12 months preceding the course start date. If there are any other circumstances, please contact FT4U for guidance.

In addition FT4U require delegates to able to provide information on a minimum of 6 months industrial experience of operating lift trucks.





Eligibility con't

Delegates must have strong literacy, numeracy and communication skills as well as an aptitude for analytical analysis. Delegates will be expected to write and deliver lesson plans and be able to digest a significant amount of written information. All delegates must be enthusiastic and prepared to complete homework assignments, ready for the next day's instruction

This is a Professional Qualification we expect delegates to be able to conduct themselves as professionals from day one!

You only get one chance on exam day to make a first impression, don't you agree?

Examination

The examination consists of 3 elements:

- 1. Practical Test of Basic Operating Skills (Maximum 25 penalties). This is usually carried out on the first day of the course by the course instructor.
- 2. RTITB Examination of Practical Instructional Ability (Maximum of 40 minutes). Delegates must score a minimum of 70 out of a possible 100.

This examination is administered on the final day of the course by an independent RTITB Examiner.

 RTITB Examination of Instructor Associated Knowledge (Maximum of 30 minutes). A minimum of 80% must be achieved. This examination is administered on the final day of the course by an independent RTITB Examiner not by FT4U.

All 3 elements must be successfully completed in order to achieve an overall pass and qualify as an RTITB Lift Truck Instructor. Following successful completion, delegates will then be eligible for entry onto the RTITB National Register of Instructors, 'The Professional Register', for a period of 5 years.
